



Chinese Language Education Programs

Chinese Language Teachers and Teaching Assistants

Educational institutions that want to employ teachers of Chinese and teaching assistants can contact an overseas mission or embassy of R.O.C. (Taiwan) for details. The MOE provides subsidies to send trained language teaching personnel overseas.

Training for Overseas Teachers of Chinese

The MOE provides subsidies (NT\$2,000 per person per day) for groups of overseas teachers of Chinese to come to Taiwan for up to 2 weeks, for further professional training.

Foreign Student Short-term Chinese Study Groups

The MOE provides subsidies of NT\$4,000 per person per week for groups of foreign students to study Chinese for 2–4 weeks.

Huayu Enrichment Scholarships

Monthly stipend: NT\$25,000.

Duration: 2, 3, 6, or 12 months.

Eligibility:

You must be at least 18, have graduated from secondary school, have excellent recent academic results, and be of good character.
