- 3. **Digital Learning and Media Developing** such as Curriculum Design, Computer Assisted Teaching, Application of Multimedia;
- 4. **Testing and Assessment** such as Test Question Design and Language Proficiency Test;
- 5. **Other Related Topics** such as Cross-Cultural Communication, Teachers Development Education, Teaching Chinese Abroad, Management and Development of Chinese Language Centers, and International Promotion and Dissemination and Chinese Language Education.

Proposal Submission:

- 1. Individual Paper: An abstract with a title and 3-5 keywords is between 400-800 words in length.
- 2. Panel Submission: A panel should include 3-4 papers with a main theme and subtitle for each paper. Materials include the main title and its content description, the relatedness of each individual paper, and a 400-800 word abstract for each individual paper.
- 3. Each individual may submit only one abstract as the first author but can be a co-author of other abstracts. If the (first) author of accepted paper is valid ATCSL member, the registration fee is not required.
