- Demonstrated commitment to language instruction, cultural education, and student engagement.
- Strong communication and organizational skills.

This position is contingent upon J-1 visa eligibility. J-visa Professors must:

- Not have completed a J-1 Professor program within the last 24 months prior to the program start date.
- Not have been in a J-visa program for all or part of the 12-month period preceding the start date unless
 - o Currently transferring within an existing professor program.
 - o Previous participation was less than six months in duration.
 - o Previous participation was as a short-term scholar.
